Meaning:

* Through * Because * On account of

Preposition that relates to movement through space, time, means or cause - it's a preposition of movement and mediation.

When used with the genitive case, [διὰ](#) emphasizes the means or channel by which something happens. John 1:3 Matthew 24:12 John 1:32 Timothy 2:10 Romans 5:1 John 1:17 [τοῦτο](#) [plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο](#)

Meaning:

* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it

Demonstrative pronoun.

[οὗτος](#) usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to [ἐκεῖνος](#) (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9 John 5:1 Matthew 3:17 John 7:26 Luke 22:19 [ἐμίσησα](#) [αὐτήν](#) [plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός](#)

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
