ESV	I will prepare destroyers against you, each with his weapons, and they shall cut down your choicest cedars and cast them into the fire.
NIV	I will send destroyers against you, each man with his weapons, and they will cut up your fine cedar beams and throw them into the fire.
NLT	I will call for wreckers, who will bring out their tools to dismantle you. They will tear out all your fine cedar beams and throw them on the fire.
