	אתַּת plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The Hebrew אתַּת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (צִוְּאוֹ בְּעַל מִלְךְ בְּבָל וְעֵבְדֹוּ) יְהוָהּ על אֲדָמָתוֹ נָאִם יְהוָהּ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big
Hebrew	hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.
