	שמר שמר Meaning: * To guard * To protect * To keep * To observe * To attend The verb שמר occurs about 470 times in the Old Testament. Central in covenant language. God “keeps” His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9Psalm 121:7Deuteronomy 7:11Psalm 127:1Luke 2:19 לִנְצַח הַנֶּה דְּבַרְתִּי דְּבַרְתָּ וּתַעֲשִׂי הָרָעוֹת וְתִכָּל
ESV	will he be angry forever, will he be indignant to the end?' Behold, you have spoken, but you have done all the evil that you could.”
NIV	will you always be angry? Will your wrath continue forever?' This is how you talk, but you do all the evil you can.”
NLT	Surely you won't be angry forever! Surely you can forget about it!' So you talk, but you keep on doing all the evil you can.”
