NIV	Is not Ephraim my dear son, the child in whom I delight? Though I often speak against him, I still remember him. Therefore my heart yearns for him; I have great compassion for him,” declares the LORD.
NLT	“Is not Israel still my son, my darling child?” says the LORD. “I often have to punish him, but I still love him. That's why I long for him and surely will have mercy on him.
LXX	κατησχύνθη Μωαβ ὅτι συνετρίβη ὀλόλυξον καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” κέκραξον ἀνάγγειλον ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. Ἀρνων ὅτι ὤλετο Μωαβ
