	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים (מִצְנַת אֲבִיהֶם אֲשֶׁר צִּנֶּם וְהָעֶם הַּיֶּה
ESV	The sons of Jonadab the son of Rechab have kept the command that their father gave them, but this people has not obeyed me.
NIV	The descendants of Jonadab son of Recab have carried out the command their forefather gave them, but these people have not obeyed me.'
NLT	The descendants of Jehonadab son of Recab have obeyed their ancestor completely, but you have refused to listen to me.'
