In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by הָאֱנָשִׁים בָּיְדוּ וַיִּבְּא בֵּית הַמֶּלֶךְ (בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים) אֶל תַּחַת הָאוֹצָר וַיִּקַּח מִשָּׁם בְּלוּי־הַסַּחֲבוֹת וּבְלוּי־מַלְחָיִם וַיִּשְׁלַח־ם אֶל יֶרְמְיָהוּ אֶל הַבּוֹר בַּחֲבָלִים
ESV	So Ebed-melech took the men with him and went to the house of the king, to a wardrobe in the storehouse, and took from there old rags and worn-out clothes, which he let down to Jeremiah in the cistern by ropes.
NIV	So Ebed-Melech took the men with him and went to a room under the treasury in the palace. He took some old rags and worn-out clothes from there and let them down with ropes to Jeremiah in the cistern.
NLT	So Ebed-melech took the men with him and went to a room in the palace beneath the treasury, where he found some old rags and discarded clothing. He carried these to the cistern and lowered them to Jeremiah on a rope.
