	קָרַבָּ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big שְׂכָרֶיהָ בְּקָרְבָּהּ hebrew Meaning * Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament. From the root קָרַב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קָרַב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalm 103:1 כָּעֲגֹלֵי מִרְבֵּק כִּי גַם הָמָּה הִפְּנוּ נִסּוּ יַחְדָּיו לֹא עָמְדוּ כִּי יוֹם אִיֻּדָם בָּא עֲלֵיהֶם עַת פְּקֻדָּתָם
ESV	Even her hired soldiers in her midst are like fattened calves; yes, they have turned and fled together; they did not stand, for the day of their calamity has come upon them, the time of their punishment.
NIV	The mercenaries in her ranks are like fattened calves. They too will turn and flee together, they will not stand their ground, for the day of disaster is coming upon them, the time for them to be punished.
NLT	Egypt's mercenaries have become like fattened calves. They, too, will turn and run, for it is a day of great disaster for Egypt, a time of great punishment.
