Hebrew	הָיָה? plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big הָיָה? hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word הָיָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. ESV	“Rise up, advance against a nation at ease, that dwells securely, declares the LORD, that has no gates or bars, that dwells alone.
NIV	“Arise and attack a nation at ease, which lives in confidence,” declares the LORD, “a nation that has neither gates nor bars; its people live alone.
NLT	“Go up and attack that complacent nation,” says the LORD. “Its people live alone in the desert without walls or gates.

KJV	Arise, get you up unto the wealthy nation, that dwelleth without care, saith the LORD, which have neither gates nor bars, which dwell alone.
