

Jeremiah 49:9

Hebrew	אִם בָּצְרִים בָּאוּ לָךְ לֹא יִשְׁאַרוּ עוֹלָלוֹת אִם גִּבְנִים בְּלִילָה הַשְׁחִיתוּ דִּים
ESV	If grape-gatherers came to you, would they not leave gleanings? If thieves came by night, would they not destroy only enough for themselves?
NIV	If grape pickers came to you, would they not leave a few grapes? If thieves came during the night, would they not steal only as much as they wanted?
NLT	Those who harvest grapes always leave a few for the poor. If thieves came at night, they would not take everything.
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" εἶπεν αὐτοῖς greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) οὕτως εἶπεν κύριος
KJV	If grapegatherers come to thee, would they not leave some gleanings grapes? if thieves by night, they will destroy till they have enough.
