	The word יהוה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.
	This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.
	* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 כְּשֶׁנֶּאֱמָר לְשׁלֵל כָּל שְׁלֵיָהּ יִשְׁבְּעוּ יהוה יְהוָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigיהוה

	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.
	First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6
ESV	Chaldea shall be plundered; all who plunder her shall be sated, declares the LORD.
NIV	So Babylonia will be plundered; all who plunder her will have their fill,” declares the LORD.
NLT	Babylonia will be looted until the attackers are gluttoned with loot. I, the LORD, have spoken!
