<p>ESV</p>	<p>I set a snare for you and you were taken, O Babylon, and you did not know it; you were found and caught, because you opposed the LORD.</p>
<p>NIV</p>	<p>I set a trap for you, O Babylon, and you were caught before you knew it; you were found and captured because you opposed the LORD.</p>
<p>NLT</p>	<p>Listen, Babylon, for I have set a trap for you. You are caught, for you have fought against the LORD.</p>

<p>KJV</p>	<p>I have laid a snare for thee, and thou art also taken, O Babylon, and thou wast not aware: thou art found, and also caught, because thou hast striven against the LORD.</p>

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
