ESV	The lovely and delicately bred I will destroy, the daughter of Zion.
NIV	I will destroy the Daughter of Zion, so beautiful and delicate.
NLT	O Jerusalem, you are my beautiful and delicate daughter- but I will destroy you!
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἀφαιρεθήσεται τὸ greek The definite article ὁ σου θυγάτηρ Σιών
KJV	I have likened the daughter of Zion to a comely and delicate woman.

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
