Hebrew	אָרֶץ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big אָרֶץ hebrew Meaning: * Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אָרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order. Genesis 12:1 לֹא נֹשָׁכָה
	ESV Be warned, O Jerusalem, lest I turn from you in disgust, lest I make you a desolation, an uninhabited land."
	NIV Take warning, O Jerusalem, or I will turn away from you and make your land desolate so no one can live in it."
	NLT Listen to this warning, Jerusalem, or I will turn from you in disgust. Listen, or I will turn you into a heap of ruins, a land where no one lives."
LXX	παιδευθήσῃ Ἱερουσαλὴμ μὴ ἀποστῇ ἡ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big οὖ greek The definite article ψυχὴ μου ἀπὸ σοῦ μὴ ποιήσω plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ποιέω Meaning: * To do * To make This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.
	Verb forms Present tense Person Greek Form σε ἄβατον γῆν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big γῆ Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words "ground", "geometry" and "geology". It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX: Genesis 1:1 Genesis 2:7 Genesis 12:1 ἥτις οὐ κατοικηθήσεται
