Hebrew	The word אֶרֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1 אֶת הָאֱלֹהִים וְאֶשְׁלַח אֲלֵיכֶם אֶת hebrew The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרֵא אֱלֹהִים (כָּל עֲבֹדֵי הַנְּבִיאִים יוֹם הַשַּׁבָּת וְשָׁלַח

NIV	From the time your forefathers left Egypt until now, day after day, again and again I sent you my servants the prophets.
NLT	From the day your ancestors left Egypt until now, I have continued to send my servants, the prophets- day in and day out.

It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again.
