Hebrew	וְאָמַרְתָּ אֲלֵיהֶם כֹּה אָמַר יְהוָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big יְהוָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. NLT	“Jeremiah, say to the people, ‘This is what the LORD says: “When people fall down, don't they get up again? When they discover they're on the wrong road, don't they turn back?”
