The word בְּרַךְ marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. Genesis 1:28 Psalm 103:1 Numbers 6:24

	ἀλλὰ ἀπόστειλον τὴν greek The definite article <i>χεῖρά σου καὶ</i> greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" <i>ἅψαι πάντων</i> greek Meaning * All * Every * The whole Adjective. Usage in the New Testament The sense of <i>πᾶς</i> depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians 1:16 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 <i>ὣν ἔχει εἰ μὴν εἰς πρόσωπόν σε εὐλογήσει</i>
