Hebrew	<p>The word הִיָּה means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.</p> <p>This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.</p> <p>* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 הַיּוֹם יִבְנֶיךָ וּבְנֵיךָ יֹאכְלִים וְשׂוֹתִים יַיִן בְּבֵית אֲחִיחֶם הַבְּכוֹר</p>

είμι is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμι is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὡς ήplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ, ή, τό
