The Hebrew **אֶת** word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article **הַ**. Genesis 1:1 **הַנְּעָרִים הָיוּ לִפִּי חֶרֶב וְאִמְלָטָה רַק אֲנִי לְבַדִּי** **לְהַגִּיד** לְךָ
