Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 **πάν**plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigπᾶς

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Meaning

* All * Every * The whole

Adjective.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 **τοῖς**plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

The definite article **συμβεβηκόσιν αὐτῷ**plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός

Meaning

* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” [οὐκ ἔδωκεν ἀφροσύνην τῷ](#)plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

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The definite article [θεῷ](#)plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεὸς

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Masculine noun meaning:

* A god or goddess * God

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
