ESV	Does not the ear test words as the palate tastes food?
NIV	Does not the ear test words as the tongue tastes food?
NLT	The ear tests the words it hears just as the mouth distinguishes between foods.
LXX	οὐς μὲν γὰρ ῥήματα διακρίνει λάρυγξ δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. οἷτα γεύεται
