ESV	He leads priests away stripped and overthrows the mighty.
NIV	He leads priests away stripped and overthrows men long established.
NLT	He leads priests away, stripped of status; he overthrows those with long years in power.
LXX	ἐξαποστέλλων ἱερεῖς αἰχμαλώτους δυνάστας δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. γῆς Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 κατέστρεψεν
KJV	He leadeth princes away spoiled, and overthroweth the mighty.
