ESV	"No doubt you are the people, and wisdom will die with you.
NIV	"Doubtless you are the people, and wisdom will die with you!
NLT	"You people really know everything, don't you? And when you die, wisdom will die with you!
LXX	εἶτα ὑμεῖς ἐστε greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be"). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἄνθρωποι ἢ μεθ ὑμῶν τελευτήσῃ σοφία
KJV	No doubt but ye are the people, and wisdom shall die with you.

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
