ESV	He uncovers the deeps out of darkness and brings deep darkness to light.
NIV	He reveals the deep things of darkness and brings deep shadows into the light.
NLT	"He uncovers mysteries hidden in darkness; he brings light to the deepest gloom.
LXX	ἀνακαλύπτων βαθέα ἐκ σκότους ἐξήγαγεν δέ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. εἰς φῶς σκιάν θανάτου
KJV	He discovereth deep things out of darkness, and bringeth out to light the shadow of death.

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
