Hebrew	גַּם לִי לֵבָב כְּמוֹכֶם לֹא נִפְלְ אֶנְכִּי מִכֶּם וְאַתּ מִי אֵין כְּמוֹ אֱלֹה
ESV	But I have understanding as well as you; I am not inferior to you. Who does not know such things as these?
NIV	But I have a mind as well as you; I am not inferior to you. Who does not know all these things?
NLT	Well, I know a few things myself- and you're no better than I am. Who doesn't know these things you've been saying?
LXX	κάμοι μὲν καρδία καθ ὑμᾶς ἐστίν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
