ESV	Behold, I have prepared my case; I know that I shall be in the right.
NIV	Now that I have prepared my case, I know I will be vindicated.
NLT	I have prepared my case; I will be proved innocent.
LXX	ἰδοὺ ἐγὼ ἐγγύς εἰμι greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. τοῦ greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ κρίματός μου οἶδα ἐγὼ ὅτι δίκαιος ἀναφανοῦμαι
KJV	Behold now, I have ordered my cause; I know that I shall be justified.

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
