ESV	Will you speak falsely for God and speak deceitfully for him?
NIV	Will you speak wickedly on God's behalf? Will you speak deceitfully for him?
NLT	"Are you defending God with lies? Do you make your dishonest arguments for his sake?"
LXX	πότερον οὐκ ἔναντι κυρίου λαλεῖτε ἔναντι δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) φθέγγεσθε δόλον
