ESV	If a man dies, shall he live again? All the days of my service I would wait, till my renewal should come.
NIV	If a man dies, will he live again? All the days of my hard service I will wait for my renewal to come.
NLT	Can the dead live again? If so, this would give me hope through all my years of struggle, and I would eagerly await the release of death.
LXX	ἐὰν γὰρ ἀποθάνῃ ἄνθρωπος ζήσεται συντελέσας ἡμέρας τοῦ greek The definite article βίου αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
