ESV	Are the comforts of God too small for you, or the word that deals gently with you?
NIV	Are God's consolations not enough for you, words spoken gently to you?

LXX	ὀλίγα ὧν greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent). It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἡμάρτηκας μεμαστίγῳσαι μεγάλως ὑπερβαλλόντως λελάληκας
KJV	Are the consolations of God small with thee? is there any secret thing with thee?

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
