	Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament. Though usually feminine, רוּחַ sometimes takes masculine verbs and adjectives, especially when referring to the Spirit of God (רוּחַ יְהוָה). Exodus 10:13 Genesis 6:17 Genesis 41:8 Proverbs 16:32 Ecclesiastes 12:7 Genesis 1:2 Judges 3:10 Ezekiel 36:27 Genesis 2:7 John 3:8 Genesis 1:2 Genesis 8:1 וְהִצָּאתָ מִפִּיךָ מִלִּין
ESV	that you turn your spirit against God and bring such words out of your mouth?
NIV	so that you vent your rage against God and pour out such words from your mouth?
NLT	that you turn against God and say all these evil things?

	greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐκ στόματος ῥήματα τοιαῦτα
KJV	That thou turnest thy spirit against God, and lettest such words go out of thy mouth?

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
