	פְּנֵים־אֵימָה לַיּוֹם יִשְׁמְרוּ אֹרֶךְ קָרוֹב מִפְּנֵי hebrew Meaning: * Face * Presence * Front or surface Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. פְּנֵי
ESV	They make night into day; 'The light,' they say, 'is near to the darkness.'
NIV	These men turn night into day; in the face of darkness they say, 'Light is near.'
NLT	These men say that night is day; they claim that the darkness is light.
LXX	νύκτα εἰς ἡμέραν ἔθηκαν φῶς ἐγγὺς ἀπὸ προσώπου σκότους
KJV	They change the night into day: the light is short because of darkness.

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
