	קָרַב hebrew Meaning * Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament. From the root קָרַב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קָרַב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalm 103:1
ESV	yet his food is turned in his stomach; it is the venom of cobras within him.
NIV	yet his food will turn sour in his stomach; it will become the venom of serpents within him.
NLT	But suddenly the food in their bellies turns sour, a poisonous venom in their stomach.
	καί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” οὐ μὴ δυνήθῃ βοηθῆσαι ἑαυτῷ χολὴ ἀσπίδος ἐν
LXX	αὐτός greek Preposition meaning “in”. γαστρὶ αὐτοῦ αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
