ESV	Bear with me, and I will speak, and after I have spoken, mock on.
NIV	Bear with me while I speak, and after I have spoken, mock on.
NLT	Bear with me, and let me speak. After I have spoken, you may resume mocking me.
LXX	ἄρατέ με ἐγὼ δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. λαλήσω εἴτ' οὐ καταγελάσετε μου
KJV	Suffer me that I may speak; and after that I have spoken, mock on.
