ESV	that the evil man is spared in the day of calamity, that he is rescued in the day of wrath?
NIV	that the evil man is spared from the day of calamity, that he is delivered from the day of wrath?
NLT	Evil people are spared in times of calamity and are allowed to escape disaster.
