ESV	or darkness, so that you cannot see, and a flood of water covers you.
NIV	why it is so dark you cannot see, and why a flood of water covers you.
NLT	That is why you cannot see in the darkness, and waves of water cover you.

It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ὕδωρ σε ἐκάλυψεν
