The word is dual in form (ending in -ים) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20Psalm 115:3 וַיֵּרָא הָרֹאשׁ כּוֹכָבִים כִּי רָמוּ
