ESV	The righteous see it and are glad; the innocent one mocks at them,
NIV	"The righteous see their ruin and rejoice; the innocent mock them, saying,
NLT	"The righteous will be happy to see the wicked destroyed, and the innocent will laugh in contempt.
LXX	ἰδόντες δίκαιοι ἐγέλασαν ἄμεμπτος δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐμυκτήρισεν
KJV	The righteous see it, and are glad: and the innocent laugh them to scorn.
