ESV	The murderer rises before it is light, that he may kill the poor and needy, and in the night he is like a thief.
NIV	When daylight is gone, the murderer rises up and kills the poor and needy; in the night he steals forth like a thief.
NLT	The murderer rises in the early dawn to kill the poor and needy; at night he is a thief.

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" νυκτὸς ἔσταιρlugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigεἰμί

greek

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὡς κλέπτης
