ESV	For deep darkness is morning to all of them; for they are friends with the terrors of deep darkness.
NIV	For all of them, deep darkness is their morning; they make friends with the terrors of darkness.
NLT	The black night is their morning. They ally themselves with the terrors of the darkness.
