Hebrew	הִמּוֹר יְתוּמִים יִהְיוּ לְחֶבְלֹו שׁוֹר אֶלְמָנָה
ESV	They drive away the donkey of the fatherless; they take the widow's ox for a pledge.
NIV	They drive away the orphan's donkey and take the widow's ox in pledge.
NLT	They take the orphan's donkey and demand the widow's ox as security for a loan.
LXX	ὁποζύγιον ὀρφανῶν ἀπήγαγον καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" βοῦν χήρας ἤνεχύρασαν
KJV	They drive away the ass of the fatherless, they take the widow's ox for a pledge.
