Hebrew	* Earth (e.g. Genesis 1:1) or world * Land * Countries or country The word אָרץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground. When coupled with heavens (שָׁמַיִם), the phrase indicates the entire created order.Genesis 12:1
ESV	They thrust the poor off the road; the poor of the earth all hide themselves.
NIV	They thrust the needy from the path and force all the poor of the land into hiding.
NLT	The poor are pushed off the path; the needy must hide together for safety.
LXX	ἐξέκλιναν ἀδυνάτους ἐξ ὁδοῦ δικαίας ὁμοθυμαδὸν ἐκρύβησαν πραεῖς γῆς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigγῆ Meaning: * Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5) Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”. It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1
KJV	They turn the needy out of the way: the poor of the earth hide themselves together.

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
