Hebrew	מִזְרֵם הַרִים יִרְטְבוּ וּמִבְּלֵי מַחְסֵה חִבְּקוּ צוּר
ESV	They are wet with the rain of the mountains and cling to the rock for lack of shelter.
NIV	They are drenched by mountain rains and hug the rocks for lack of shelter.
NLT	They are soaked by mountain showers, and they huddle against the rocks for want of a home.
LXX	ἀπὸ ψεκᾶδων ὀρέων ὑγραίνονται παρὰ τὸ greek The definite article μὴ ἔχειν αὐτοὺς greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) σκέπην πέτρᾱν περιεβάλοντο
