Hebrew	וַיֵּמָּה יִצְדָק אָנוּשׁ עִם אֵל וַיֵּמָּה יִלְדָּה אִשָּׁה
ESV	How then can man be in the right before God? How can he who is born of woman be pure?
NIV	How then can a man be righteous before God? How can one born of woman be pure?
NLT	How can a mortal be innocent before God? Can anyone born of a woman be pure?
LXX	πῶς γὰρ ἔσται greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. δίκαιος βροτὸς ἔναντι κυρίου ἢ τίς ἂν ἀποκαθάρσαι ἑαυτὸν γεννητὸς γυναικός
KJV	How then can man be justified with God? or how can he be clean that is born of a woman?

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
