	Masculine noun. The word is dual in form (ending in -ים) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20Psalm 115:3 יְרוּפּוּ וְיִתְמָהּ מִגְעָרָתוֹ
ESV	The pillars of heaven tremble and are astounded at his rebuke.
NIV	The pillars of the heavens quake, aghast at his rebuke.
NLT	The foundations of heaven tremble; they shudder at his rebuke.
