Hebrew	The word ⲕⲓⲓⲓ means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 ⲕⲓⲓⲓ ⲓⲙⲧⲕⲟⲙⲙⲓ ⲕⲉⲛⲓⲗ
ESV	“Let my enemy be as the wicked, and let him who rises up against me be as the unrighteous.
NIV	“May my enemies be like the wicked, my adversaries like the unjust!
NLT	“May my enemy be punished like the wicked, my adversary like those who do evil.

	οὐ μὴν δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἀλλὰ εἴησαν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. οἱ greek Meaning: * The The definite article.
