ESV	Man puts an end to darkness and searches out to the farthest limit the ore in gloom and deep darkness.

NLT	They know how to shine light in the darkness and explore the farthest regions of the earth as they search in the dark for ore.

Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
