Hebrew	שָׂרִים עָצְרוּ בְּמַלְאִים יָכֹף יְשִׁימוּ לְפִיהֶם
ESV	the princes refrained from talking and laid their hand on their mouth;
NIV	the chief men refrained from speaking and covered their mouths with their hands;
NLT	The princes stood in silence and put their hands over their mouths.
LXX	ἀδροὶ δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐπαύσαντο λαλοῦντες δάκτυλον ἐπιθέντες ἐπὶ στόματι
KJV	The princes refrained talking, and laid their hand on their mouth.
