NIV	who are filled with gladness and rejoice when they reach the grave?
NLT	They're filled with joy when they finally die, and rejoice when they find the grave.
LXX	περιχαρεῖς δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐγένοντο ἐὰν κατατύχωσιν
