Hebrew	רוּחַ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big רוּחַ hebrew Meaning: * Wind * Breath * Spirit Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament. Though usually feminine, רוּחַ sometimes takes masculine verbs and adjectives, especially when referring to the Spirit of God (רוּחַ יְהוָה). ESV	Terrors are turned upon me; my honor is pursued as by the wind, and my prosperity has passed away like a cloud.
NIV	Terrors overwhelm me; my dignity is driven away as by the wind, my safety vanishes like a cloud.
NLT	I live in terror now. My honor has blown away in the wind, and my prosperity has vanished like a cloud.
LXX	δέ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”.
