Hebrew	כִּי טוֹב קִוִּיתִי וַיָּבֹא רָע וְאַחֲלָה לְאֹר וַיָּבֹא אֶפֶל
ESV	But when I hoped for good, evil came, and when I waited for light, darkness came.
NIV	Yet when I hoped for good, evil came; when I looked for light, then came darkness.
NLT	So I looked for good, but evil came instead. I waited for the light, but darkness fell.
LXX	ἐγὼ δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐπέχων ἀγαθοῖς ἰδοὺ συνήντησάν μοι μᾶλλον ἡμέραι κακῶν
KJV	When I looked for good, then evil came unto me: and when I waited for light, there came darkness.
